



Job Title: Water Treatment Plant Operator

Job Description: The Town of Dillon is currently seeking a highly motivated, results-oriented, team player for the position of Water Treatment Plant Operator for the Town of Dillon in Colorado.

The Water Treatment Plant Operator is responsible for performing a variety of skilled, semi-skilled, and routine tasks, including facilities maintenance, cleaning/janitorial, equipment maintenance, facilities operation, laboratory work, data entry, and field inspections. Maintenance and operations include the operation, optimization, and upkeep of the Town's membrane water treatment plant, distribution system, sewer collection system, cross connection program, raw water storage and intakes, and GIS information systems.

Qualifications:

The following knowledge, skills and abilities are essential and critical to successful performance in this position:

Considerable Knowledge of:

Modern water treatment practices, hydraulic principles, water quality regulations and routine water quality analysis.

Pumps, electric motors, piping, control systems and other equipment common to water treatment facilities.

Methods and precautions in storing and handling of chlorine and other hazardous chemicals.

Water quality sampling and other process control tests.

Computers, SCADA Systems, GIS, and MS Office

Occupational hazards and necessary safety precautions applicable to maintenance and operations work.

Skills and Abilities:

Make adjustments to various equipment and processes using established procedures.

Establish and maintain cooperative and effective working relationships with co-workers, supervisors, other city staff, and the public.

Relate to others in a courteous and respectful manner.

Maintain a work environment free of discrimination, harassment, and retaliation,

Ability to touch type proficiently.

Work safely and in compliance with Federal and State laws, Town policies and standards.

The ability to effectively communicate and interact successfully in a team environment; and an ability to work independently and gain a clear understanding of goals and objectives

This position requires participating in the "on-call" rotation, work on evenings, weekends, and holidays as needed.



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Eligibility Requirements:

Must be a high school graduate or equivalent, and a minimum of two years of college-level coursework or equivalent technical training in chemistry, biology, environmental science, hydraulics or related field. Relevant work experience may substitute for the college-level education requirements.

A valid Colorado Driver's License within 30 days.

Minimum possession of a Colorado Water Treatment Operator Level D license is required. Water Distribution certification, Sanitary Sewer Collection certification, experience with the operation of a membrane treatment facility are highly desirable. Out of State certifications will be considered.

The successful candidate must be able to obtain a Colorado Water Treatment Operator C Certificate within 30 months and Colorado Water Treatment Operator B Certificate within 42 months of appointment date.

Copies of required Water Treatment Operator certification and additional certifications should be submitted with employment application.
